WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

- 1. The scholarship consists of financial aid of \$1500 for each of two applicants.
- 2. Payment of the scholarship will be made in two parts. One half will be mailed to you in each of the two semesters when you provide the Hartford Players with a letter from the Registrar on the institution showing your enrollment in each of the semesters.
- 3. This scholarship is not exclusive, and applicants will be considered for this scholarship without regard to any other scholarships which they might receive.
- * Please note that an awarded scholarship must be used for the semesters following the award and will be forfeited if not used for the year awarded.

TO WHAT TYPE OF PROGRAM WILL THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLY?

- 1. Any accredited college or university
- 2. Any program (one year minimum) offered at an accredited technical or vocational technical school or conservatory
- 3. Other study and/or training programs in the Arts as may be approved by the Board of Directors of Hartford Players, Ltd.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP?

Any graduating senior or high school graduate who resides within the Hartford Union High School or Slinger High School district and who is pursuing advanced education or training in the performing or creative arts. Students outside these districts will be given consideration if they have been or are involved with the Hartford Players as active members in recent productions.

Performing or creative arts include, but are not limited to, the following: vocal or instrumental music, dancing, acting, still or moving photography, videography, visual arts, graphic arts, creative writing, theater arts, etc.

HOW WILL SELECTIONS BE MADE?

- 1. Cumulative Grade Point
- 2. Family information and background
- 3. Performance in classes relating to the applicant's artistic field
- 4. Co-curricular activities and out-of-school activities, including community service and involvement
- 5. References
- 6. Honors and awards received
- 7. Statement of goals and interests
- 8. Example of applicant's work
- 9. Selected finalists shall give an audition or presentation, as well as an interview, to the Board of Directors. (Tentative date for finalist presentations mid March)

APPLICANTS SHOULD SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. High school transcripts and college transcripts (if applicable)
- 3. Three letters of recommendation, including one from a teacher who has worked with the applicant in that applicant's artistic field
- 4. An example of the applicant's work in whatever medium is best suited to the artistic field. (Examples: audio tape, video tape, photographs, photo copies, etc.) In a field where this requirement is not practical (i.e. theatrical lighting) describe in writing your experience and accomplishments
